12	Junior entry open to those under 13 - a hyacinth growing in water	1

Helpful suggestions

Classes 1 to 7 to be displayed in clear glass vases or jars approx 20cm in height


Classes 8 to 11 to be displayed in a bowl, pan or pot approx 17cm outside diameter

All cut flowers and exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor & been in their care at least 3 months prior to the show

As bulbs take months to grow it is advised to plan ahead and plant bulbs in the autumn - the label on the packet will give information as will the RHS website and on the Stenton Horties Facebook (all welcome to join).
